

JOURNEY TO DIVINE

ADI KAILASH, PARVATI LAKE AND OM PARVAT YATRA

Adi Kailash, often referred to as Chota Kailash, is a holy mountain in the Indian state of Uttarakhand that rises 5,945 metres above sea level. The holy mount Adi Kailash is considered to be the replica of holy Mount Kailash, This holy abode of lord Shiva and Ma Parvati is situated in Jyolingkong near village Kuti, the last village in India's Kumoun area in the District area of Pithoragarh.

Kuti, a town on the Indo-Tibetan border, is named after Mata Kunti, the legendary Pandava family's mother and one of the most important figures in the Mahabharata. You get to see the ruins of fort of the Pandavas here in Kuti.

Adi Kailash, also known as Baba Kailash, is thought to be the residence of Lord Shiva, who shares this location with Goddess Parvati and their offspring, Lord Ganesha and Lord Kartikeya. Thus, no other spiritual journey can provide the amount of inner peace, great power, and self-purification than the darshan of Adi Kailash, which is also better referred to as one of the most sacred pilgrimage.

This venerable Adi Kailash yatra begins from Haldwani and then to Patalbhubneshwar to Dharchula to Kalapani to Kuti, Nabi, Pithoragarh and back to Haldwani. The pilgrims will experience the temples of Haat Kalika temple and cave temple at Patalbhubneshwar, Jageshwardham temple, temples in Pithoragarh and the majesty of the snow-capped Annapurna Mountains, the Garhwal, Kumoun Himalayas and the Nepal Himal, lush forests, the gushing Rivers, the vibrant gardens of Narayan Ashram, an abundance of flora, and multiple cascading waterfalls on this moderate to difficult route.

In addition to this, pilgrims will pass by the renowned Kali Temple at Kalapani, which is around 9 kilometres from the beautiful Aum or Om Parvat, during their auspicious Adi Kailash journey. Om Parvat is situated in the beautiful Himalayas at a height of 5,570 metres. Om Parvat got its name because the melting snow at the peak resembles the holy symbol in Hinduism, "Om". Visitors will also explore the miraculous stream in Sumchuma, which is close to Adi Kailash. It's an amazing stream that, on a rotational basis throughout the year, flows for three days and then stops for the following three days. Moreover, visitors are going to visit blessed water bodies including Parvati Sarovar, and Gauri Kund on this sacred journey. We will also visit and offer prayers at Shiva temple at Adi Kailash.



DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 01: Delhi to Bheemtal

To start a trip to Adi Kailash and Om Parvat travellers from different parts of the country will arrive at Delhi, We will start our journey by 10:00 AM from Delhi pick up points are either Airport/Railway station(Delhi to Kathgodam/ Haldwani one way transfer by Innova). We will reach Haldwani/Bheemtal by evening 6:00 PM.

The main entry points for Kumoun region in Uttarakhand are (Pantnagar Airport nearest airport is now connected and is being connected to many metropolitan cites) Haldwani/Kathgodam is an important place and entry point for visiting not only Adi Kailash, Om Parvat Tour and many other pilgrimage sites of Kumoun, (Uttarakhand,) but it is also an important point for Kailash Mansarovar Yatra the Indian traditional path/route to Kailash Mansarovar.

On reaching Delhi we will regroup at Railway station or at Airport where our Cars (Innova) will pick our clients. We will board by 10:00 AM. Reach Haldwani/Kathgodam by 5:00 PM in the evening. Lunch and tea will be provided on the way. Dinner and night stay will be at Bheemtal.

We will have our Breakfast Lunch and tea on the way side restaurants and dinner at Bheemtal after reaching.

We can go for boating and site seeing also.

Day 2 Bheemtal to Babaji Cave and night stay at Ranikhet

We will start early after breakfast, enroute visiting several important pilgrimage sites, NeemKaroli Baba temple at Kenchi Dham, and then go straight to Babajis cave at Kukurchina and after visit return to Ranikhet in the evening. Stay and food arrangements will be in the hotel. Ranikhet meaning 'Queen's Meadow', Ranikhet is a tranquil cantonment town tucked away in the Almora district of Uttarakhand. Dotted with lush fruit orchards, ancient temples and colonial buildings, it offers stunning views of the mighty Kumoun Ranges.

Mahavatar Babaji cave is the Most Spiritual Caves in Himalayan Region, which is the origin of Kriya yoga and Where Yoga Guru Lahiri Mahasaya got Kriya Yoga teachings directly from Mahavatar Baba Ji.

Every day many pilgrims and Kriya Yogis that follow different gurus visit the cave.

Breakfast at Bheemtal, Lunch at Kukurchina dhaba, tea and dinner at Ranikhet.

Day 3 Ranikhet to Patalbhubneshwar

We will start early in the morning, we will visit the famous Sun Temple at Katarmal (Almora) The Katarmal Surya Temple is a 9th-century temple built by Katarmalla, a Katyuri King, exhibiting the architectural style of the ancient artisans. This Hindu temple is perched at an elevation of 2,116 meters above sea level and is situated at a distance of 19 kms from Almora. This Surya Mandir (Sun Temple) is also known as Badaditya (Baraditya) Temple. After darshan we will go to Jageshwar Dham temple and will reach there by lunch have Darshan and lunch.



A serene temple town located in the Almora district of Uttarakhand, Jageshwar is a cluster of more than 100 stone temples, dedicated to Lord Shiva, which have inspired its popular name, "Valley of Gods". Jageshwar Dham is known as one of Jyotirlinga (Astham Jyotirlingas - Nagesham Darukavane). In many traditional scriptures, it is revered as one of twelve original Jyotirlingams. It is also known as Valley of Gods & dates back from 7th to 14th centuries in its different forms of reconstruction.

We will move after lunch and in 4 hours reach Haat Kalika and then to Patalbhubneshwar.

Situated amidst the dense deodar forests, the Haat Kalika temple at Gangolihat in Pithoragarh district boasts an exquisite complex area. It is believed that the Goddess Kali shifted her abode from West Bengal to this place and has been the popular goddess in the area ever since.

This Shakti-Peeth established by Guru Adi Shankaracharya is more than thousand years old.

Day 04: Patalbhubneshwar to Dharchula

After breakfast the group will go and visit the famous Cave temple and after darshan we will move for Dharchula We will have lunch enroute and will reach by evening.

Situated at a height of 3500 feet above sea level, Dharchula is a tiny beautiful town in the lap of beautiful mountains of Kumoun Uttarakhand. Surrounded by the mountains from all sides, Dharchula is divided in two parts by Kali River. Travelling through the Indo-Nepal borders we will reach Dharchula an important trade centre and gateway to Adi Kailash and Kailash Mansarovar. In order to reach Adi Kailash we need to have/take the Inner line Permit so last minute formalities if needed has to be complete. Night stay and dinner will be in the hotel at Dharchula.

Included meals: Veg Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 05: Dharchula to Kalapani

Kalapani is a very pious and holy place we have the famous Kali temple situated here and we will be staying in a beautiful camp. After reaching Kalapani we will have darshan of the KaliMata temple and offer Prayers here. This place is also strategically important place as it is very close to the china border. Dharchula to Kalapani after breakfast will drive through Pangla, Mangti, Malpa, Budi village and the beautiful meadows of Chialekh, the sinking village of Garbyang village Napalchu and Gunji enroute enjoying splendid views of the mountains, Api Himalaya the Annapurna range, waterfalls and rivers.(It's so Godly.) Food and stay will be at Kalapani Camp.

Included Meals: Veg Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 06: Kalapani to Kuti

Today the travellers will get up early, drive to Nabidang for Om Parvat Darshan and possibly to Old Lipu for Kailash darshan if permitted. After darshan of both we will come back to Kalapani Camp and have breakfast and head for Kuti the sacred village of ma Kunti. On our Journey today we will see Vyas Gufa Sesh Nag Parvat Om Parvat Kali temple and then village Gunji Vyas temple Nabi and then Kuti village lunch tea dinner and stay here. We will have our stay at Heritage house some 250 years old. We will visit the Old Pandava fort and the local traditional village.

Stay and food will be provided here

Included Meals: Veg Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner



Day 07: Drive to Jyolingkong Adi Kailash and back to Kuti/Gunji

We will start after breakfast probably early. We will drive to Adi Kailash but here to visit Parvati Sarovar and Gauri Kund you will either have to trek the route or take horse.

Today the main aim is to have darshan and spend maximum time in worship and inner solace. We will reach Jyolingkong in less than one and half hours. On the way we will have darshan of Brahma Parvat at Nikurch and also see the amazing stream (Sumchuma) that, on a rotational basis throughout the year, flows for three days and then stops for the following three days. Then to Jyolingkong, straight away have darshan of Adi Kailash we will trek/horse to Parvati Sarovar and offer prayers at Shiva temple here we can go for a holy dip in the Parvati Sarovar and also take a Parikrama in the lake take photos (where Modiji was Snapped) and meditate and also can perform rituals like homa and yagya. Don't forget to take blessing from the Lama priests in the temple. You can also visit the pious Gauri Kund and offer prayers. You don't forget to take the holy waters from Parvati Lake in containers.

Day 08: Kuti/Gunji to Pithoragarh

After having visited all pilgrimage site including Adi Parvat, Om Parvat and Parvati Kund, today we will start our return journey. Drive to PITHORAGARH. It will take about 9 hours to reach Pithoragarh. We will start after breakfast and lunch on the route probably at Pangla and reach Pithoragarh by evening. Night stay and dinner at Pithoragarh It is a very picturesque and beautiful hill station.

Included Meals: Veg Breakfast Lunch Tea and dinner

Day 09: Pithoragarh to Haldwani

We will start after breakfast we will be going via Tanakpur and we will visit Mayawati Ashram/Vivekananda Ashram at Lohaghat. We plan to have our Lunch at Champawat. We will reach Haldwani by evening. Mayawati Ashram is 9kms from Lohaghat; this ashram is situated at an altitude of 1940 meters. Mayawati shot into prominence after the Advait Ashram was established here. The ashram attracts spiritualists from India and abroad. Amid and old tea Estate, is the Advait Ashram of Mayawati. During his third visit to Almora in 1898, Swami Vivekananda decided to shift the publication office of 'Prabuddh Bharat' from Madras to Mayawati, from where it is published since then. The only presence that has become a part of the peace and solitude of Mayawati is that of the mighty Himalaya in its entire splendour. On request the Ashram provides board and lodging to visitors. There is also a library and a small museum at Mayawati.

WE WILL REACH TANAKPUR by late afternoon, and then travel to Haldwani.

Included Meals: Veg Breakfast, Lunch tea and dinner.

Day 10: Haldwani to Delhi

After breakfast check out from the hotel and start the onward journey to Delhi.
